




Are you aware of the Whitehouse Community Council?



Which community event would you like to see happen soon?








Once allotments become available, would you be interested to manage one?




Would you be willing to join and participate in a community neighbourhood watch?


Would you be interested in helping the community with regular litter picks to help maintain Whitehouse as a nice place to live?






What issues or concerns do you have about living in Whitehouse? Please number these options below from 1 to 10 with 1 being your biggest concern and 10 being your lowest concern
